



Unique family weekend: 4q deletions

With generous support from Jeans for Genes and the Grocers' Charity we are running a series of 5 groundbreaking weekend family meetings in 2010. Each weekend will focus on a particular rare chromosome disorder and will bring together families of those affected, geneticists, paediatricians, behaviour experts and therapists to help increase our knowledge of the conditions. Older families will be able to share longer-term outcomes and new families will be helped to better understand their child's condition. We trust that research studies will be stimulated and new findings reported for the first time.

We also want the weekends to be a chance for families to relax and meet others in a similar position and have carefully chosen accessible, family-friendly venues. They will take place over the course of 5 weekends in 2010 in hotels in the Midlands which will be available to our families from 2pm on the Friday to 11am on the Sunday on each weekend. Time will be set aside during the weekends to meet and chat with other families or just to relax and unwind in the hotel.

The **4q deletions** family weekend will take place over the weekend of 9th-11th April 2010 at the Novotel Hotel, Coventry, West Midlands, UK.

We have negotiated competitive rates with each of the hotels and the support from Jeans for Genes and the Grocers' Charity means we will be able to subsidise many of the costs of running each of the weekends. Our aim is to keep overall costs to families as low as possible.
